

## WHAT TO BRING ... to overnight camps

**Bedding:** Sleeping bag or twin sheets, blanket, pillow

**Toiletries:** Soap, towels, toothbrush & toothpaste, comb/brush, deodorant, shampoo, sun block, insect repellent

**Clothing:** Casual, comfortable clothes for any time, play clothes for outside fun, shoes, socks, underwear, pajamas, jacket, hat



**Swimwear:** Girls are required to one-piece suits; boys are to wear trunks

**Miscellaneous:** Flashlight, camera, BIBLE, notebook, pen/pencil

**Skate park items:** Helmet, knee and elbow pads, skateboard, rollerblades, bike

**Label your stuff:** Putting your name on all your belongings will help in recovered lost and found items. What is not picked up will be donated to help others.

## ... to Kids Kamp

Bring swimsuit, towel, and sun block. Dress in fun play clothes.

## DIRECTIONS

### From the North/South

Get on I-65; take exit 247 – Crown Point/US 231. Left/west onto US 231; go to the 2<sup>nd</sup> light. Right/north on Ind. 53/ Broadway; go to 1<sup>st</sup> light Right/east on 113<sup>th</sup> Ave.; this is the camp road. 113<sup>th</sup> twists and turns for 5 miles (be careful) and turns into 117<sup>th</sup> Ave. Just past Chicagoland Christian Village, Town & Country church shares a drive with LRCA; turn right/south.

### From the West

US 231 thru Crown Point; veer right, around courthouse; thru light at Ind. 55/S. Indiana Ave. Just past Crown Feed & Supply, US 231 begins to curve right. Go left/east on W. 113<sup>th</sup> Ave. This is intersection is unmarked, but First Savings Bank sits back off the road. 113<sup>th</sup> twists and turns for 6 miles (be careful) and turns into 117<sup>th</sup> Ave. Just past Chicagoland Christian Village, Town & Country church shares a drive with LRCA; turn right/south.

### From the East

US 30 west, past Deep River Water Park, to 1<sup>st</sup> light after park Left/south on Randolph St. Go 4.5 miles, just past Jerry Ross Elementary School, to 4-way stop. Right/west on 117<sup>th</sup> Ave.; this is the camp road. Less than 1 mile, Town & Country church shares a drive with

## CHECK IN TIMES

- For Kids Kamp – 8:30-9:00am
- For all overnight camps – 6:00-7:00pm  
For overnight camps, no evening meal is served the first night. Please feed your kids before you bring them.



## CHECK OUT TIMES

- For Kids Kamp – 3:00pm the same day
- For overnight camps – 3:00pm the last day of camp



## WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOU BRING YOUR CHILD

### FRONT GATE

- **Sign a register** and indicate who is bringing in which children.
- Go straight down the main road to the Assembly Building.

### ASSEMBLY BUILDING

- Meet the **dean** and the camp staff.
- Receive an **index card**.
  - ♦ On it will be the cabin/hogan assignment and any balance due.
  - ♦ There is a line for the camper's signature.
  - ♦ The second line is for any non-parent or guardian who will pick up your child when camp is over. *Note: If the pick-up person changes during the camper's stay, LRCA must be notified or we will not release your child!*
- A **wristband ID** will be given to each camper. It must be worn during the camper's entire stay at LRCA.
- **Camp T-shirts** can be picked up by campers who pre-ordered them or who purchase them on the spot.
- **Camp pictures** may be ordered (\$10). They will be handed out on the last day of camp.

### SPENDING MONEY?

- **Canteen cards** can be purchased for kids (\$10 each). These punch cards take the place of cash and we suggest the kids have no cash at camp. (Canteen items include pop, water, slushies, candy, nachos, etc.)
- **Missions money** can be designated for your child to give to the week's mission. We suggest an equal amount for Canteen and Missions. Unused Canteen cards will be donated to the mission.



### MEDICAL STUFF



- The Medical Form is part of the Registration Form. The Dean and Nurse share these files.
- **Medications** must be given to the **camp nurse**. Please have written instructions about all the child's meds. *Note: All medicine is to be in its original container.*

After all this, you can settle your kids into their **cabins/hogans**.

## WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOU RETRIEVE YOUR CHILD

- State your name at the **front gate**. You will be directed to the campers.
- **Camper's luggage**, bedding, etc. will be by the shelter by the parking lot.
- You need to pick up **meds** from the camp Nurse.
- **Sign out at the front gate:** Sign next to all campers in your vehicle.



## CAMPER MAIL

- To send your child mail at camp, use the camp address. Make sure the camper's name and camp week are plainly written on the outside of the letter or package.
- You can also e-mail your camper at the camp address.

### Camp LRCA Guidelines

- Faculty members and campers are to abide by the schedule unless excused by the program director.
- No one is permitted to leave the camp without the permission of the program director or manager. With permission, you must sign out at the camp office.
- All visitors must check in at the camp office upon arrival to the camp.
- Any sickness or injury must be reported to the camp nurse.
- **In matters of dress, Christian modesty must prevail at all times.** No halter tops, tube tops, bare midriff, strapless attire, flip flops, exposed underwear, short shorts, or shirts with inappropriate graphics or words. No bared cleavage or buttocks.
- No one is to go barefoot on the camp grounds at any time!
- Any camper causing property damage will be held accountable for the cost.
- No food or drinks are allowed in the cabins or chapel.
- Cursing and the use of tobacco, drugs, and intoxicants are prohibited on the camp.
- The program director or camp manager reserves the right to reprimand or dismiss any camper or faculty member who does not conform to these guidelines.

### What Not to Bring

- No weapons, guns, knives, fireworks.
- **Leave all electronics at home:** CD player, iPod, MP3 player, video game, CELL PHONE.
